The City of Sparks Parks and Recreation Department offers facilities and parks to fit your needs. We make it easy for you to plan your special event, whether it is a family gathering, wedding, corporate picnic or other special events. Groups interested in renting space for exclusive use may do so on a first-come, first-served basis. Groups are responsible for their own setup and cleanup. PARK RENTALS

Permits are issued upon application approval on a first-come, first-served basis for group picnic use at the parks listed in the table below. No alcoholic beverages are allowed unless a liquor waiver has been secured. Alcohol is not permitted at the Sparks Marina Park. Note: There are other park picnic areas available for use by small groups. These areas are available on first-come, first-served basis only.

SPARKS MARINA PARK

The Sparks Marina Park is one of the largest parks in Sparks. Year-round activities and facilities include fishing, swimming, picnics, boating (no gas engines and must be hand launched), scuba diving, wind surfing, 2-mile walking/running trail, volleyball courts, playgrounds, showers, a dog park and a concession stand during the summer months. Lifeguards are on duty in the designated swim area, weather permitting, during the summer months (Dates TBA). Swimming, fishing, picnic areas, restrooms, showers, and the trail are all ADA accessible. If you have a disability and cannot hand launch your vessel, please call the park rangers at 691-9130 prior to your arrival.
