Re: Update regarding COVID-19

Last night it was decided by the City of Sparks that all facilities and programs will be closed immediately until April 6<sup>th</sup> due to health concerns with the COVID-19. We emailed everyone letting them know that practices have been cancelled.

Currently the adult softball leagues are scheduled to begin on April 6<sup>th</sup> and we will keep you updated regarding picking up schedules and balls.

The start date for the adult softball league may be pushed back if the City decides to keep the closures longer than April 6<sup>th</sup> on the recommendation of the Health Department. As soon as we hear more information, we will send out emails to keep you apprised of the situation.

We have no intention at this time of cancelling the adult softball programs all together. The City will continue to monitor the situation and push the start date back as much as needed.

Once we have more final information and a start date is established if a team feels that they need to request a refund we will be glad to offer you the paperwork to get that accomplished. We hope that all of you are patient with us during this difficult issue. Public safety is our first concern.
